Pastor's Column Catch the Spirit!

Lots of Spirit-filled activities will take place at UPC on **Pentecost Sunday, May 19**. Pentecost is the day when the Spirit of God came upon the disciples after Jesus' resurrection and inspired them to come out from hiding and proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ. So many people became followers of Jesus after hearing the disciples' testimony that Pentecost is often called the "birthday" of the Christian Church.

We are celebrating God's gift of the Holy Spirit with a lot of energy this Pentecost Sunday. We will hold a **single worship service at 11 a.m.** to reflect how the Spirit unified the followers of Christ. 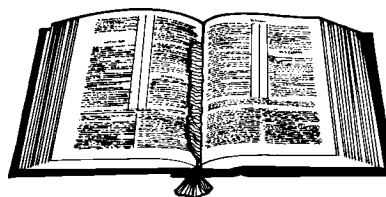

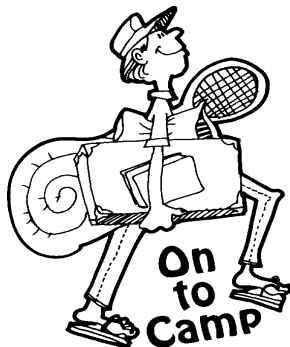
